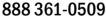

Maximum PC Performance

If you really want to boost vour PCs performance vou should consider a memory upgrade!

I worked on a system last week that took over 4 minutes just to boot up. After a basic tune and a 1 GB memory upgrade, it sprung to life

Memory prices have dropped so low, most computers can have a 1 GB memory chip added for around \$50. Prices vary based on specific system requirements.

Check List for Keeping Your Computer Healthy

When a computer finds its way to me, it's usually a pretty sick puppy. Often, its infected with some kind of malware, but usually there is problem that could have been avoided with a little preventative maintenance. Here's a checklist for keeping your computer healthy (and out of my shop).

- 1. Keep your computer area free from contaminants. Liquid is electronics' worst nightmare. Just a little slosh of coffee on your notebook keyboard and it's history. Keep all liquids away from your PC.
- 2. Make sure your computer is well-ventilated. Your PC needs to circulate fresh air to keep it cool. Heat damage can ruin your CPU and your HDD. For desktops this means that you need to make sure the air and fan vents are clear of

obstructions and dust.

Clumps of dust can be vacuumed away with your vacuum's brush attachment. Don't enclose your PC in tight cabinets unless you provide for adequate ventilation.

You should always be sure your notebook is on a flat surface. Notebooks have little rubber "feet" that allow them table clearance for ventilation. Often air is drawn from the bottom and blown from the back of the PC. Despite their name, if you rest your laptop on your lap or a blanket, you will defeat the cooling mechanism. A lap tray or special notebook cooling fans (\$20-\$30) will protect your PC.

4. Run regular disk checks and defrag your HDD. Sometimes there is nothing you can do to prevent HDD failure.

However, regular disk checks will clue you in on pending problems. The disk defrag is primarily to keep you computer performing at it's peak. It is a necessity, if you use your PC a lot.

4. Keep your anti-virus and spyware software up-to-date.

If you don't use anti-malware software, you are playing with fire. There are free programs available that can give you basic coverage. Google "free AVG" and you'll get a link to AVG's free download. I'll try to put some good links on my website as well.

5. Keep your Microsoft Office and Windows software up-to-date. You can use Window's Update to schedule regular automatic updates — including important security updates. If you don't know how to do this,

search for "Windows Update" in your start menu search bar.

6. Back up! Back up! Back up!
Problems will_occur, the only question is whether you'll be ready! Back up you data at least weekly. Daily is better if you use your PC for business.

7. Watch for warning signs.

Slowed PC activity, constant need for reboots, sudden auto reboots, delayed shut down, unexplained data loss, inability to open files, frequent error messages, noisy fans or no fan noise are all warning signs of trouble on the way.

8. Get regular PC checkups. Dr. Joey recommends at least once a year check ups. More, if you depend on your computer for business. I continue to offer \$25 discounts on both my Basic and Advanced Tune ups. See my ad or call (888) 361-0509.

The best selling product on



the market is
Norton AntiVirus. I have
used Norton
in the past
and have
been reas o n a b I v

pleased with its performance. My only complaint was that, to me, it seemed to slow down my computer. I found myself turning it off for better performance, but then I ended up defeating the whole purpose of antivirus software.

The second-best selling product is **McAfee Anti-virus**.

I used this product for years and actually preferred it to Norton. The only reason I



don't use it now is cost. It is reasonably priced- much like the others, but why pay \$40+ a year for a product when similar ones are available for free..

I am now using the free ver-

sion of AVG
by Grisoft.
Sure, it lacks
some of the
bells and
whistles of
full security
suites like



Norton and McAfee, but in 2-3 years of use, I have yet to have a problem. There are some limitations, though.

One major limitation is that the free version is not licensed for business use.

AVG does have a full-featured version that retails for about the same price as the others. It is as good—give or take — as the more popular ones..

Conclusion? Why buy when you can get great protection for free. When I do a tune up, if the customer has expired or no antivirus protection, I usually install AVG Free. However, you really can't go wrong with any of these choices.
