Family Calendars can be made with a photo scanner (or digital pictures), a photo quality printer, photo quality paper, & most photo software.

Add a DVD burner and some video editing software & you are well on your way to making **photographic DVDs**.

Video/Film to DVD trans-

fer is a bit more complicated due to some specialized equipment required. Video cards that allow input from camcorders and VCR's are required to get the video into your computer for editing. Film transfer requires two steps. You need to record the film projection on video tape and then transfer it to your computer for editing.
